LEGACY BIKE RIDE

Wednesday, May 13, 8:00 - 12:00 pm

Legacy Bike Ride along the new 14 mile Legacy Parkway sponsored by Outdoor Utah. The route is paved, very flat and scenic so will make for a fun outing for all abilities. This is not a race! One-way ride (about 90 minutes, shuttled to the Redwood Road trailhead and head north to the Farmington Station) and round-trip ride (from Farmington Station heading south and back) options available. Advance reservations are required and there is no charge, but no shows will be billed \$25. Outdoor Utah will provide water bottles, snacks and beverages on the way and lunch at the end. A limited number of rental bikes and helmets (required of all riders) available from Bikers Edge in Kaysville for \$35. Some loaner bikes/helmets available from Outdoor Utah at no charge. As far as Outdoor Utah is concerned, the more the merrier!

HORSEBACK RIDING AT ANTELOPE ISLAND STATE PARK

Enjoy horseback riding at Antelope Island State Park with a special price of \$75 for a two hour ride. Expect to pay an additional \$9 per car for access to Antelope Island State Park. R & G Horse and Wagon offers exclusive horseback trail rides on historic Antelope Island, a 28,000 acre island in the Great Salt Lake. All rides are led by experienced wranglers that are intimately familiar with the island and its rich history. Horses are gentle and well trained. They have appeared in several feature films including "Far and Away", "Donner Party", and "Stranger on My Land".
